First Fruits	The day after the first sabbath after Pentecost	Exodus 12	Resurrection (New Life)	Christ's Resurrection	First grains gathered from the fields	Ex 23:14-19; Lev 23:9-14
Pentecost/Weeks	50 days after the sabbath of Passover	Exodus 19	Celebration of the harvest	Pentecost (Acts 2)	Leavened bread, 7 lambs, bullock, 2 rams, drink offering	Lev 23:15-22; Deut 16:9-12, 16-17

Tabernacles/ Booths	15th day of seventh month (Tishri) lasts 7 days	Exodus 34:29-40:1	Remembrance of years in the wilderness and God's provision; gathering of materials for the tabernacle	Millenium and Eternity	Day 1: 13 bullocks; Day 2: 12 bullocks Day 7: 7 bullocks	Lev 23:33-44; Num 29:12-40; Deut 16:13-15
